What is the Anointing of the Holy Spirit?

There are some circles of Christianity that feel they have a corner on the market when it comes to the Holy Spirit. I'm gonna have to say a big no on that one, the Holy Spirit is offered to every one who chooses Option A: Christ as their propitiation for sin.

Some circles call this the "Baptism in the Holy Spirit" which as I understand it is a separate event from water baptism or belief. Others call it an "Anointing" and by this my understanding is that it means a special gift of the HS for a special gifting or special holy calling. For the majority of Christian-dom these terms mean something different that it does to those circles. We need to get to the bottom of this... because if you need a special anointing and don't have one, then you might need that right?

Ok, so let's look at this from a Biblical perspective, truth from the Bible being the only measuring rod. I really have little interest in man's traditions at this point. I just want to make sure I am always within the lines as far as God sees it.

Acts 10:38 "how God <u>anointed</u> Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

The language that anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit is not new. There are dozens of Anointing throughout the Bible, typically with oil. In the Know Your God series we shoed the Holy Spirit is symbolized at times and referred to as <u>Oil</u>... so it is not a far reach to see the God's anointing, which is supernatural would mirror the instructions he gave to the hebrews with physical oil.

Anoint: (gk) *chrio*- (kree-oh) it properly means to touch with the hand, or to besmear, it is used exclusively of two related things:

- 1) the consecration and delivery of powers via the Holy Spirit of God necessary for Jesus Christ for all he needed from God to have all he needed to preach the gospel & deliver people from sin.
- 2) it is also used of providing Christians with the gifts of the Holy Spirit

This word was only used 5x in the Bible, of course there is a Hebrew counterpart... but since we are under the New Covenant, we are going to stick with this one for now. Here are the 5 with emphasis to help us define what this anointing is:

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed.

*This is a quote from <u>Is 61:1</u>- in the Heb the word in greek for anoint in the hebrew is *epi*-which mean upon, tom come over, against, like smooth breathing onto a superimposition, a touching at or beside, *masah*: to smear, anoint to consecrate, to ordain

Acts 4:27 For truly against Your holy Servant <u>Jesus whom You anointed</u>, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered there.

*this was part of a prayer... against = is a preposition epi: translated upon, against, to be over; in old language against meant next to so close it is touching.

Acts 10:38 how <u>God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit</u> and with <u>power</u>, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, <u>for God was with Him.</u>

2 Cor 1:21-22 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

Hebrews 1:9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the <u>oil of gladness</u> more than your companions.

*this verse is regarding Jesus: so Jesus had the maximum anointing

The other word used for anointing is *chrisma*. This is only used 2x in the Bible both related to a religious anointing for priests. Remembering that Christians are referred to as a Royal Priesthood, this applies to all true Christians.

chrisma: an anointing of an ointment, oil, typically by the hebrews mixed with herbs, for an inaugural ceremony for priests

*Ps 45:7-8 describes the herbs: myrrh, aloes, cassia (which is a powdered bark like cinnamon)

1 John 2:20 But ye have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.

*the know all things in context is referring to the reason for the entire letter, to clarify the deceptions of the last hour, and reinforcing the truth they already know, pointing our the lies.

How can we KNOW if we have this anointing?

1 John 2:3-6 Now by this <u>we know that we know Him</u>, if we <u>keep His commandments</u>. He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we re with Him. He who says he <u>abides in Him</u> ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

*abide- meno: to remain, to not depart; to last, to endure; to not become another;

1 John 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

*abide- meno: to remain, to not depart; to last, to endure; to not become another;

So, if you are keeping his commandments, and abiding, it is because the Holy Spirit has anointed, which will cause you to abide.

Ok from these 8 verses let's recap what the Bible has said.

1 The Spirit of the Lord is from God

2 The Various Names for the Holy Spirit in just these verses:

- -The Spirit of the Lord
- -The Holy Spirit
- -The Spirit
- -The Oil of Gladness
- -The Holy One

3 Specific to Jesus~ But we can glean functions and source

Anointing:

- -from God
- -comes upon/so close next to leaning on
- -Jesus has the maximum anointing (so there must be levels of filling right?)
- -means God is with Him

Reason for the Anointing:

- -preach the gospel/poor
- -heal/broken hearted
- -proclaim liberty/captive
- -recover sight/blind
- -liberty/oppressed

4 For the Christian

- -God establishes us with Christ
- -God anoints us
- -God seals/guarantees us with The Spirit

The Anointing of the Spirit:

- -gives believer all knowledge of the truth
- -causes God to abide in You
- -teaches you
- -cases you to abide in Him

So this anointing,... not according to man, but according to the Bible, and focusing on 1 John 2:25-29 says anyone with the Holy Spirit is securely held unto eternal life. Anyone that is filled with the Holy Spirit, has a secure salvation, and from that point on everything they do is in the Spirit and not in the flesh. So if you pray in the Spirit that is like saying a real christians praying and the Holy Spirit is inspiring and interpreting what you say to God. It s not a special ecstatic state. I sometimes hear people say things like "Oh that was my flesh..." Sorry, but for a person who is indwelled with the Holy Spirit that is not possible. Can you sin yes, but the Bible is explicit about being in the flesh and that is only related to those not saved. Since words actually mean things let's look at what being in or walking in the flesh looks like.

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to <u>those who are in Christ Jesus</u>, who <u>do not walk according to the flesh</u> the law of sin.

John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profit's nothing. The words I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

Rom 2:28-9 For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that is outward in the flesh; but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.

Rom 7:5 For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were around by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death

We know from

Rom 9:8 That is, those the children of the flesh, these are not the children of God; but the children of promise are counted as the seed.

Rom 8:8 So then the flesh cannot please God. <u>But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.</u> now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His

The big theological trouble is that people argue if salvation is secure or not right? Salvation is 100% secure, <u>for a person indwelled with the Holy Spirit</u>. The real question is are you indwelled with he Holy spirit

Rom 13:4 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

How do we "put on" Christ?

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

SO to put on Christ is to have faith in Him.

And how do we know what the lusts of the flesh are? to be sure we are not walking in them?

Gal 5:16-21 I say then: walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are evident which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murder, drunkenness, revelries and the like; of which I told you before hand just as I told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

This verse is capped off by the fruit of the Spirit, simplified in this chart,

and a few verses later it makes this whole question of anointing and how to walk crystal clear when it says in

Galatians 5:25 if we live in the Spirit, let us walk in the Spirit.

Basically those that are <u>actually filled with the Holy Spirit will be pressed to obey</u> by the Holy Spirit and will stay clear of the "big no-no" list and the HS will develop the fruits in their life. This does not mean everyone will me at the same levels of maturity though. We are only expected to bear the fruit we have been coached through by the Holy Spirit, and a bit why we have no perspective to judge others, because we do not know what their path is with the Lord. The way to test is as it says in 1 John

1 John 2:3-6 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But, whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

So it goes back to observing a person, or yourself, do they or you look like the fruit from the correct tree? Do they produce Godly fruit? Are they aiming at walking in Christlikeness? If so they are walking by the Spirit, if so they are anointed by God with the Holy Spirit and no one can snatch that person away from God.

John 10:28-9 And I give eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

So if <u>God is the one who gives you the anointing of the Holy Spirit</u>, and God has promised that His Spirit will keep you secure, and <u>when you have that Spirit you walk in the Spirit</u>,

God loves His children and wants us to have every needed tool, gift, fruit and interaction in order to have success to stay faithful and war against team satan. Walking in the Spirit brings us full circle to spiritual warfare, in that only those with the Holy Spirit war in the Spirit against team satan... the fighters, all of them are by definition, anointed and secure in their salvation.

2 Cor 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

I hope this helps clarify what many of the confusing concepts are around being Anointed with and Walking In the Holy Spirit refer to Biblically.
