The False Messiah is not The Anti-Christ ~ Clarifying any Confusion~

There seems to be some confusion between the recent messages I was givens shared about the false messiah and the antichrist, who are not the same person. So I feel the need to stop and connect the dots before moving on, become some deeper things are coming. We all have to get on the same page.

To make it simple when reading the Matthew, Mark and Luke accounts, it is easy to see there are several end times players on team satan. We gain additional wisdom by consulting Daniel and Thessalonians, Jude as to who is who.

Let's start at the beginning, the scariest person to most is the antichrist who houses legions of demons and is given his power by satan himself.

Let's start with the basics. I'm going to define the terms:

Christ

It may be new information to some, that Jesus Christ, the very name, defines him as the Messiah, The Son of God and The Salvation promised through the entire Old Testament.

Matthew 1:1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ....

Jesus: (gk) iesous (yay-soos)- Jehovah is Salvation, Jesus the son of God, God incarnate, the savior of mankind

*it is of hebrew origin from yehosua (yeh-hoe-shoo-a)- which means Joshua which means Jehovah is salvation

Christ: (gk) christos (khrees-tos)- anointed, the messiah, the son of God

Daniel 9:25 talks about the Messiah coming

....Until Messiah the Prince...

Messiah: (heb) masiah (maw-shee-awkh)- anointed, the Messianic Prince, The Messiah

These two connect the dots

John 4:25-6 connects the dots

The woman said to Him, "I know that <u>Messiah</u> is coming" (who is called <u>Christ</u>). "When He comes, He will tell us all things." <u>Jesus said</u> to her, "<u>I</u>who speak to you <u>am He</u>"

Acts 17:3 explaining and demonstrating that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead-end saying, "This is Jesus whom I preach to you is the Christ"

Antichrist

In the most simple terms there is a difference between <u>an antichirist</u> and <u>The Antichrist</u>. These verses help to clarify

1 John 2:18 Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that *the antichrist* is coming, even now *many antichrists* have come. This is how we know it is the last hour.

THE Antichrist: (qk) antichristos (an-tehchkree-toss) the adversary of the The Messiah

many antichrists: (gk) polys antichristos (pah-loose) a great number of adversaries of The Messiah

1 John 2:22-23 Who is the liar? It is <u>whoever denies that Jesus is the Christ</u>. Such a person is <u>the anti-christ</u>— <u>denying the Father and the Son.</u>

1 John 4:3 but <u>every spirit</u> that does not acknowledge *Jesus* is not from *God*. This is the *spirit of the antichrist*, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

Daniel 9:27 Then <u>he</u> shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to the sacrifice and offering. And on the <u>wing of abominations</u> shall be <u>one who makes desolate</u>, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.

abominations: (heb) siqqus (she-kootz) a detestable idol or thing, an abomination to the Lord, an idol of a false god as used by pagans, Babylonians, etc.; often relating to the highest pagan god, Baal, Zeus, lord of heaven, Marduk, Jupiter, Saggitarious "The Archer", and in Rev it will be the first Beast, The Antichrist

make desolate: (heb) samem (shaw-mame) to astound, to ravage in horror and appalling nature, to lay desolate(barren, desert, depopulate, miserable, devastate), to cause ruin, to destroy masterfully so that everything is silent and quiet because it is a wasteland

Daniel 11:31 And forces shall be mustered by *him*, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and <u>place there</u> the abomination of desolation.

Matthew 24:15 Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation', spoken of by <u>Daniel</u> the prophet, standing in the Holy place"....

Daniel 11:37 He shall regard neither the God of his fathers nor the desire of women, or any god; for he shall exalt himself above them all.

the God: (heb) elohim (el-oh-heem) the true Gd

2 Thes 2:3-4 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

sin: (gk) hamartia (ahm-are-tee-uh) to miss the mark, to wander from the law of God, to violate God's car, sin, an offense of divine law in thought or act

perdition: (gk) apoleia (app-oh-lie-uh) a destruction which consists of eternal misery in hell, the utter destruction of vessels, money, land

2 Thes 2:8-10 and then *the lawless one* will be revealed, whom *the Lord* will consume with the breath of *His* mouth and destroy with the brightness of *His* coming. The coming of *the lawless* one is according to the working of **Satan**, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

lawless one: (gk) anomos (annah-mahs) destitute of the Law of Moses, a wicked person who violates God's law, a violator of the law, used often of the gentiles, unlawful, wicked

Rev 13:3 And I saw one of *his* heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and *his* deadly wound was healed. And <u>all the world marveled and followed the beast</u>

Rev 13:8 All who dwell on the earth will worship <u>him</u>, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the <u>Lamb</u> slain from the foundation from the world.

False Messiah

Anyone who calls himself Christ, or the Messiah (which is what Christ means) is <u>a false</u> messiah, but there is also <u>The False Messiah</u> which is what the recent videos have been about.

Matt 24:23-24 Then if anyone says to you, 'look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it. For false christ's and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

False christs: (gk) pseudochristos (sue-dough-khrees-tos)- a false messiah, a false Christ, one who falsely lays claim to the name and office of the Messiah

Mark 13:21-22 "Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!" or 'Look, He is there!' do not believe it. For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

Luke 21:8 And *He* said: "Take heed that you are not to be deceived. For *many* will come in *My name*, saying, '*I am He*,' and, '*The time has drawn near*." Therefore do not go to after them

Matt 24:5 "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.

my name: (gk) mou onoma (moo ah-nah-mah) my (belonging to the person speaking) the name used for everything which a name covers, all that is rounded by the mind when a thought, feeling, hearing, remembering the name including it's rank, authority, interests, deeds, etc.

False Prophet

There are also *false prophet* and there will be <u>The False Prophet</u>. A false prophet is typically strongly associate with <u>sorcery</u>, but applies to all who are not genuinely of God that pretend to deliver God's message. Look at these to define between a false prophet and the false prophet...

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheeps clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

1 John 4:1 Dear friends do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to whether they are from God, because *many false prophets* have gone out into the world

False prophets: (gk) pseudoprophetes (sue-dah-pra-ay-tace) one who is acting the part of a divinely inspired prorphet of God, but utters falsehoods under the name of God, a false prophet; a religious imposter that pretends to foretell truth

Acts 13:6, 8 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain <u>sorcerer</u>, a <u>false prophet</u>, a Jew, who's name was Barjesus;.... But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, <u>seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith.</u> (the purpose)

Sorcere: (gk) magos (magas)- the name given by the Babylonian's, Persians, Pagans etc. (team s) to their wise men, teachers, priests, physicians, astrologers, seers, soothsayers, sorcerer, interpreters of dreams; by association it represents magicians, false prophets and sorcerers that have their power from the evil one who rules all the false worship systems through time like Babylonian.

Barjesus: (gk) bariesou (barre'-soo) - son of Jesus, a certain names Isrealite, false prophet

Elymas: (gk) elymas (el-ooh-mas) - the Arabic name for a Jewish magician or sorcerer, a 'wise' man

Matt 24:23-24 Then if anyone says to you, 'look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it. For false christ's and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

2 Thes 2:9-10 The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with *all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception* among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Rev 13:11-17 Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like lamb and spoke like a dragon. And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes all the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. He performs great signs, so that the even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs

which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. He causes all, both small and great, rich a poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, and that no one may buy or sell except one ho has the mark of the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

beast: (gk) therion (thah-ree-on) a wild venomous beast, metph. a wild brutal savage ferocious man... incidentally used of Cretans in Titus 1:12... and they were calls this is a derogatory sense because they were Pagan and worshiped a bull/beast and they were very rough, violent people who made human sacrifices to baal. This will repeat with the AC

dragon: (gk) drakon (drah-cone) a dragon, a great serpent, a name for Satan, the devil

signs: (gk) semeion (say-my-on) a remarkable event, wonder, or a miracle, (especially ceremonially or supernaturally) typically used to authenticate to men that a person is sent by God

Rev 19:20 The beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Ok, that these verse should seriously clarify who is who right?

But, if you want to stick around for a little freebee lesson about how these characters fit into the order of events in the Matthew, Mark and Luke Accounts of Jesus explaining the end times... I will take a second and show you.

Matthew 24:3-31

3 As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately. "Tell us," they said, "when will this happen, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?"

4 Jesus answered: "Watch out that no one deceives you. 5 For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Messiah,' and will deceive many.

6 You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. 7 Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. 8 All these are the beginning of birth pains.

9 "Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me. 10 At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, 11 and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. 12 Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, 13 but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved. 14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

15 "So when you see standing in the holy place 'the abomination that causes desolation,'[a] spoken of through the prophet Daniel—let the reader understand— 16 then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

17 Let no one on the housetop go down to take anything out of the house.

18 Let no one in the field go back to get their cloak. 19 How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! 20 Pray that your flight will not take place in winter or on the Sabbath. 21 For then there will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world until now—and never to be equaled again.

22 "If those days had not been cut short, no one would survive, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened. 23 At that time if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Messiah!' or, 'There he is!' do not believe it. 24 For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. 25 See, I have told you ahead of time.

26 "So if anyone tells you, 'There he is, out in the wilderness,' do not go out; or, 'Here he is, in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. 27 For as lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. 28 Wherever there is a carcass, there the vultures will gather.

29 "Immediately after the distress of those days

"'the sun will be darkened,

and the moon will not give its light;

the stars will fall from the sky,

and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.'[b]

30 "Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth[c] will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory.[d] 31 And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

9 "You must be on your guard. You will be handed over to the local councils and flogged in the synagogues. On account of me you will stand before governors and kings as witnesses to them. 10 And the gospel must first be preached to all nations. 11 Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit.

12 "Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child. Children will rebel against their parents and have them put to death. 13 Everyone will hate you because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved.

14 "When you see 'the abomination that causes desolation'[a] standing where it[b] does not belong—let the reader understand—then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. 15 Let no one on the housetop go down or enter the house to take anything out. 16 Let no one in the field go back to get their cloak. 17 How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! 18 Pray that this will not take place in winter, 19 because those will be days of distress unequaled from the beginning, when God created the world, until now—and never to be equaled again.

20 "If the Lord had not cut short those days, no one would survive. But for the sake of the elect, whom he has chosen, he has shortened them. 21 At that time if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Messiah!' or, 'Look, there he is!' do not believe it. 22 For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. 23 So be on your guard; I have told you everything ahead of time.

24 "But in those days, following that distress,

"'the sun will be darkened.

and the moon will not give its light;

25

the stars will fall from the sky,

and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.'[c]

26 "At that time people will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory. 27 And he will send his angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of the heavens.

28 "Now learn this lesson from the fig tree: As soon as its twigs get tender and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. 29 Even so, when you see these things happening, you know that it[d] is near, right at the door. 30 Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. 31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

12 "But before all this, they will seize you and persecute you. They will hand you over to synagogues and put you in prison, and you will be brought before kings and governors, and all on account of my name.

13 And so you will bear testimony to me. 14 But make up your mind not to worry beforehand how you will defend yourselves. 15 For I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict. 16 You will be betrayed even by parents, brothers and sisters, relatives and friends, and they will put some of you to death.

17 Everyone will hate you because of me. 18 But not a hair of your head will perish. 19 Stand firm, and you will win life.

20 "When you see Jerusalem being surrounded by armies, you will know that its desolation is near. 21 Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those in the city get out, and let those in the country not enter the city. 22 For this is the time of punishment in fulfillment of all that has been written. 23 How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! There will be great distress in the land and wrath against this people. 24 They will fall by the sword and will be taken as prisoners to all the nations. Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

25 "There will be signs in the sun, moon and stars. On the earth, nations will be in anguish and perplexity at the roaring and tossing of the sea. 26 People will faint from terror, apprehensive of what is coming on the world, for the heavenly bodies will be shaken. 27 At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. 28 When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

29 He told them this parable: "Look at the fig tree and all the trees.
30 When they sprout leaves, you can see for yourselves and know that summer is near. 31 Even so, when you see these things happening, you know that the kingdom of God is near.

32 "Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. 33 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

34 "Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap. 35 For it will come on all those who live on the face of the whole earth. 36 Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man."
