#12 The Water

Ps 47:1-2

1 As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God. 2 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.When shall I come and appear before God?

As the deer pants for the water, so my soul longs after You.

What does this mean?

Imagine it. When does a deer pant? When he is of thirst. Why? Water is the natural replenishment for humans and animals. Water brings life to cells, refreshment and satisfaction & it cools the body. Water also detoxifies and increases metabolic function.

So you should pant after or seek in earnest after the living water for your soul.

What is living water?

My Son's Words are <u>the</u> living water.

They bring hydration, satisfaction and refreshment to the soul.

They detoxify and increase spiritual function.

Why?

This is how humans were designed.

To thirst for Holy Leadership.

But if you thirst for it and do not find it, you still thirst, just like human body in a desert without water. Only those who drink of the Living Water liberally, the Words of Jesus, can be refreshed, and properly satisfied and detoxified and function properly.

You could do a lifetime without spiritual refreshment from the Living Word, and when this occurs a person will finally try to drink any and everything, but it does not refresh or bring satisfaction. But, I designed humans to thirst after Holy Leadership, it is the only thing that brings true satisfaction. So by attaining the words, and reading them and rereading the Words of Jesus—

this is the only way to true refreshments.

As the deer seeks after water, this is how the author of this Psalm felt, the same passion of his soul to know and be refreshed by the Lord.

Who is like the Lord? No one! I designed you and I gave you the directions of how to be fulfilled. See that I have your best interest in mind.

#12 Verses
